We will be raising the height of the rough to get ready for the cooler months.

We do this to help with the cart traffic on the Bermuda grass. This helps to give the rough enough density to take the traffic and be ok come spring time.

We will also be putting out pre-emergent chemicals to control the poa annual around the over seeded areas. We will be putting out our winter grass (overseed). On the greens and collars and approaches on October 24. We will be putting out our winter grass on the fairways and tees on October 28th.

We ask that you keep carts out of fairways for 2 weeks from the 28th to allow us to establish the winter grass. This is the grass we will have till next summer. Thanks for your help.
