Terry Stephenson-Maintenance Supervisor

- We are still transitioning from the winter grass to the bermudagrass.
- We are verticutting, spiking, topdressing and fertilizing the greens on a weekly basis
- to push the bermudagrass to fill in the weak areas.
- We will start to treat the Goosegrass on the greens when the Bermuda gets more coverage. We have treated the greens and tees and select fairways for nematodes.
- We have fertilized the entire course to promote growth.
- We will be finishing up edging bunkers and cart paths this month.
- We plan to resod the nursery green as well as some of the weaker area on the greens with sod sometime in June.
- We will be treating other areas for weeds as time allows.
- We are watering as much as we can to stay within our allocation of water from Saint Johns since we have had very little rain.
- We are also airifying the edges of cart paths as well as tees, fairways and roughs .

Thanks to the members for all the tree work on the course and to the maintenance staff for all the hard work.
